Mr. Ashby,

In accordance with 40 CFR 423.19(f)(3), Indian River Generating Station (Indian River) is hereby providing an annual progress report for the Notice of Planned Participation for permanent cessation of coal combustion for the Indian River Generating Station generating units (Unit 4) submitted on October 13, 2021.

Interim Milestones Narrative as of October 13, 2022

A detailed timeline to achieve permanent cessation of coal combustion is not yet available as deactivation notice previously submitted to PJM have resulted in a Reliability Must Run Order. When available, this information will be provided in future annual progress reports. Regardless, permanent cessation of coal combustion is estimated to be achieved no later than December 31, 2028.

Please note the following.

- Indian River would like to preserve the option to choose a different compliance pathway at the facility if circumstances change. This flexibility is contemplated by the ELG Rule.
- Indian River Unit 4 is under a Reliability Must Run Order from PJM which is currently planned to expire on December 31, 2026. Any extension of the RMR can affect the timeline of cessation.
