In accordance with 40 CFR 423.19(f)(3), Midwest Generation, LLC (MWG) is hereby providing an annual progress report for the Notice of Planned Participation for permanent cessation of coal combustion for the Powerton Generating Station's generating units submitted on October 13, 2021.

Interim Milestones Narrative

A detailed timeline to achieve permanent cessation of coal combustion is not yet available as deactivation notices have not been submitted to PJM. This information will be provided in future annual progress reports once available. Permanent cessation of coal combustion is estimated to be achieved no later than December 31, 2028.

Please note that MWG would like to preserve the option to choose a different compliance pathway at Powerton Generating Station if circumstances change. This flexibility is contemplated by the ELG Rule.
