NRG Texas Power LLC ("NRG Texas") received a December 31, 2025 TCEQ-determined compliance date for Part 423-regulated ("ELG Rule") bottom ash transport and Flue Gas Desulfurization (FGD) water discharges to surface waters of the state at the W.A. Parish Electric Generating Station (Parish) located in Fort Bend County, Texas. NRG Texas is working diligently on an ELG Rule compliance path for Parish.

As such, NRG Texas is withdrawing the Notice of Planned Participation, as it relates to permanent cessation of coal burning activities, which was submitted to TCEQ on a contingent basis on October 13, 2021, and its related updates.
