1. PURPOSE

Pursuant to 40 CFR 257.80(c), this document provides the annual fugitive dust control report for NRG Texas Power LLC's (NRG) Limestone Generating Station near Jewett, Texas.

Since the prior Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report (dated December 13, 2017), no specific measures beyond the control measures presented in the plan were required to control CCR fugitive dust at the Limestone Generating Station. No citizen complaints have been recorded regarding CCR fugitive dust at the Limestone Generating Station and, as such, no corrective measures have been taken beyond the established CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan procedures.

2. CONCLUSION

NRG will continue to review and evaluate the effectiveness of the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan, complete and retain CCR Fugitive Dust Monitoring Reports at least quarterly, and record and address citizen complaints as required in accordance with the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan.
