Rick, Ted and Darin,

Pursuant to the requirements of §257.94(b), the first round of Detection Monitoring samples was collected from the CCR monitoring wells associated with the Lincoln Stone Quarry (II000216), operated by Midwest Generation, LLC. In accordance with §257.93(h), analytical results from the downgradient wells were reviewed and evaluated to identify the potential existence of statistically significant increases (SSIs) over background groundwater concentrations. This evaluation, completed on January 12, 2018, did yield the identification of SSIs for several Appendix III constituents across multiple downgradient well locations. As there were no efforts performed in support of an Alternate Source Demonstration for Lincoln Stone Quarry, and in consideration of the SSIs being valid and representative, an Assessment Monitoring Programs for Lincoln Stone Quarry is being established to comply with the obligations of §257.94(e)(1).

Accordingly, this notification is being made by Midwest Generation, LLC to satisfy the requirements of §257.94(e)(3), including documented placement of this information into each of the facility's operating records [§257.105(h)(5)] within 30 days of establishing an assessment monitoring program. This notification is being further provided to the State to comply with the obligations of §257.106(h)(4), and will also be posted on the publicly accessible website per §257.107(h)(4). This posting will be available within 30 days on our public website at <http://www.nrg.com/legal/coal-combustion-residuals>.
